NAARVA consists of thousands of members from four regions of the US (Northern, Southern, Eastern and Western). Triangle RVers are Members of the Eastern Region to which each coach pays dues of \$10 a year. NAARVA dues are \$60.00 a year and must be paid directly to NAARVA online at www.naarva.com. \$10 of this fee will be sent to the Eastern Regional by NAARVA. Dues must be current in order to attend the Eastern Regional or NAARVA National Rallies each year. Our Triangle RVers Club dues are \$55.00 a year for each coach. Our annual club dues are due on January 1 of each calendar and are past due after January 15. Dues are not prorated. They are \$55 upon joining the club, for the calendar year joined, and are then due again the following year on January 1. Checks are to be mailed to Triangle RVers Club and sent along with your membership application for the Triangle RVers Club to our Financial Secretary, Patricia King at 5712 Whippoorwill Street, Durham, NC 27704. If you wish to join and pay membership dues on our website. www.trianglervers.com, (via PayPal) the charge will be \$58 which covers PayPal fees.


